Whereas sealed tenders were invited by Department of Tourism to dispose of condemned vehicle no. GA-07-G-0247 (Tata Sumo) by Auction Notice dated 03/07/2020 and tenders were received and opened on 29/07/2020.

And whereas in terms of O.M No. 7-4-2013/Fin.(Exp.) dated 08/07/2013, where the bids received is more than 25% below the upset price, the Department is required to display the details of the vehicles, the upset price and the highest bid received (only the amount) on the notice board and website for the general public to respond to the notice.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF AUCTION TENDER NOTICE.

1. The Department invites sealed bids for disposal of unserviceable vehicles as described in the Public Notice on "As is where is basis".
2. GST/TAX Payable will be collected from all the successful bidders at the prevailing rates on the amount quoted by the bidder on the bid articles at the time of final payment.
3. Tender complete in all respects should be submitted/ dropped in tender box kept in Department for this purpose within the closing time and date specified. Tender as far as possible shall be opened as mentioned in Public Notice.
4. E.M.D. will be at the rate of 25% of the quoted bid value for disposal of per vehicle. The same shall be in the form of D.D./pay order/D.C.R of any Schedule Bank drawn in favour of Director of Tourism, Panaji, Goa payable at Panaji and to be enclosed by all bidders alongwith their Annexure Document.
5. The balance 75% of highest bid value of lot should be paid by the bidder within 7 days from the date of issue of sale letter/ acceptance letter by the Department to the successful bidder.

The Balance payment shall also be in the form of pay order/D/D/D.C/R of any scheduled Bank drawn in favour of Director of Tourism, Goa Payable at Panaji. In case of failure to make balance payment in time the amount deposited shall stand forfeited.

6. The Successful bidder shall lift lot within 3 weeks of receiving intimation letter/delivery order from Department and failure to do the same then the amount deposited shall stand forfeited.
7. The Tenders shall be treated as having been concluded as soon as sale letter is issued by the Department to the successful bidder.
8. The Person signing the schedule of lot will be deemed to be the only authorized representative of the tenderer for any or all Transactions with Department.
9. Tenders which are not complete in all respect and/or not supported by documents as mentioned in Clause (4&5 above) or are with conditions are variance within terms and conditions of tender are liable to be rejected summarily.
10. In case of unsuccessful tenderers the security Deposit (EDM) will be returned within 8 days after the date of auction. The EDM of the second highest bidder will be returned only after finalization of sale with the highest bidder.
11. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
